

When you feel like a day out, take a drive or the village bus to the local country markets


or lawn bowls club, Morayfield Shopping Centre or Caboolture Square, or even the nearby historical village.

Pet Friendly


Furry and feathered friends of residents and staff are welcome at St Paul's and many of our retirees, as well as aged care residents, share their homes with pets.

St Pauls' dedicated 24-hour nursing staff and aged care specialists are on hand, with high quality dementia care, medication support and leading palliative care available.



Chefs On Site


Nutrition is a daily priority at St Paul's, and all meals are freshly and lovingly prepared by our onsite chefs.

- Nursing, allied health and other therapies.


